



***COMPETITOR GUIDELINES FOR
COMPETITIONS TO BE HELD
AT BOXGROVE COMPETITION STABLES***

We are pleased to announce that the above competition is going ahead, however, the following guidelines **MUST BE** adhered to. If anyone is shown to be ignoring these guidelines, they will be asked to leave the competition/venue.

- Everyone attending should take their temperature before they depart for the competition.
- Anyone displaying COVID-19 symptoms, however mild, should stay at home. Anyone who has been in contact with someone that is showing symptoms, or is vulnerable, should stay at home.
- Social distancing and government advice must be adhered to.
- In line with BRC current guidelines, all competitors details will be held for NHS Test and Trace.
- Lorries will be parked with either a 5 or 3 metre gap between them, the car park steward will advise accordingly.
- Riders are allowed **ONE** extra person on site with the, this can be a family member, friend, groom or owner. If the rider is under 18, two people are allowed to attend.
- If you are attending alone, you must be able to tack up/mount/do your girth etc. alone, as we can not maintain social distancing if we were to help you.
- Spectators are **NOT** allowed, and will be asked to leave.
- Your warm up time is limited to 40 minutes, please do not go to the warm up arena until this time, as you will not be allowed to enter, and will be asked to return back to the lorry park to wait.
- Please mount in the lorry park and ride to the arenas.
- Only the stewards are to open/close any arena gates.

- You must not leave the warm up arena for your test until the steward asks you to do so.
- The only people permitted in the indoor arena are the judge, judge's writer, rider and their one person who has accompanied them (or 2 if the rider is under 18). Any droppings will be cleared up by the steward provided.
- If you require your test(s) to be called, please bring your own caller, but this person must be your one allowed extra person.
- There will be a strict one way system in place, which must be followed.
- Please turn up, ride your test and then head straight back to the lorry park, following the one way system, as you are not permitted to re-enter the warm up arena. This allows us to keep numbers to a minimum.
- There will be NO access to Boxgrove livery yard, including the toilet facilities.
- There will be no catering on site.
- Test sheets and rosettes will be available to collect from the car park steward approximately 20 minutes after each class. If you are unable to collect, please leave a stamped addressed envelope with the car park steward.

These measures are in place to protect you and everyone else involved in the show, so your patience and understanding will be much appreciated during these unprecedented times.
