GENERAL RULES & CONDITIONS:

Placing will be decided with the rider gaining the highest combined score from the PTV and Control of Paces phases taking the first prize. In the event of equality the highest score from PTV will take precedence.

RULES AS PER THE TREC GB RULEBOOK AVAILABLE TO DOWNLOAD FROM

1. Competitions are open to all horses and ponies providing that they are a minimum of 4yrs of age.
2. Riders any age, juniors may ride horses and seniors may ride ponies.
3. No rider will be permitted to start any phase of the event unless wearing a hard hat, which meets current standard recommended by the BHS (PAS 015 or ASTM F 1163 and bearing kite mark or SEI) that is properly fitted and fastened with a chinstrap.
4. Riders may choose to wear a body protector during any phase of the competition. If worn, Beta 3 2009 standard is strongly recommended.
5. Tack & dress informal but safe. Riders must wear suitable riding footwear.
6. Standing Martingales and other fixed reins are forbidden.
If a running martingale is used, horse must be led from headcollar and lead rope for led PTV obstacles.
7. Whips must not exceed 75cm. Spurs, if worn, must be rounded, not exceeding 3.5cm in length and pointed downwards.
8. The judges and officials decision is final and must be complied with at all times. Un-corrected error on PTV course will result in a ZERO score for the PTV.

WINTER ARENA TREC (UNAFFILIATED)

1. IN-HAND
Horse OR rider never to have competed in ANY affiliated TREC competition. PTV obstacles equivalent to Level 1. No MA (control of paces)
2. STARTER
PTV obstacles equivalent to Level 1. There will be an MA in this class
3. NEWCOMER
One rider to complete MA canter and PTV obstacles 1-5. Second rider to complete obstacles 6-10 and MA walk. Open to all. PTV obstacles equivalent to Level 1
4. PAIRS
Score as many points as you can in 3 minutes. A minimum of 5 different obstacles must be attempted.
Any obstacle may only be completed a maximum of twice. Obstacles may be tackled in any order. Scores will only be given for completed obstacles – if you are part way through an obstacle when the bell/whistle sounds that obstacle will not be scored.
5. TOP SCORE

Entries close Wednesday 9th December 2020.

THE COMPETITION CONSISTS OF TWO PHASES, EXCEPT THE IN-HAND & STARTER CLASSES 1 & 2 (NO MA):

1. MA - Canter as slowly as possible along a measured track around the outside of the arena. Then walk back along the track as quickly as possible. Each section being awarded 50% of the points normally given at a full Trec. (Maximum score is 15 for canter and 15 for walk).
A change of pace or step outside the marked track will result in zero for that pace.
2. PTV course of TEN obstacles, simulated to represent those you might meet out hacking, designed to test riding skills, the training of your horse and the accord between you. Maximum score is 10 marks per obstacle. Suitable for all levels of rider and any type of horse or pony these may include bending, a small jump, leading, mounting from a block, and reinback. If you wish to leave out an obstacle you simply stop and inform the judge before bypassing it.

Full details will be displayed on the day and a brief, guided course walk will be held before the Starters Class. The course will be open for walking for 5 minutes before each of the other classes

WHAT DO WE WEAR?

Safe and comfortable riding wear (there is no requirement for show jackets or plaiting up the horse), and your horse or pony's usual tack, will be fine. Please read the rules!
